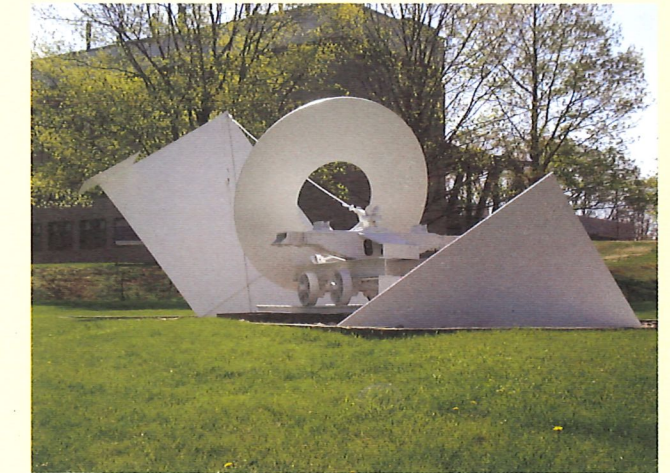

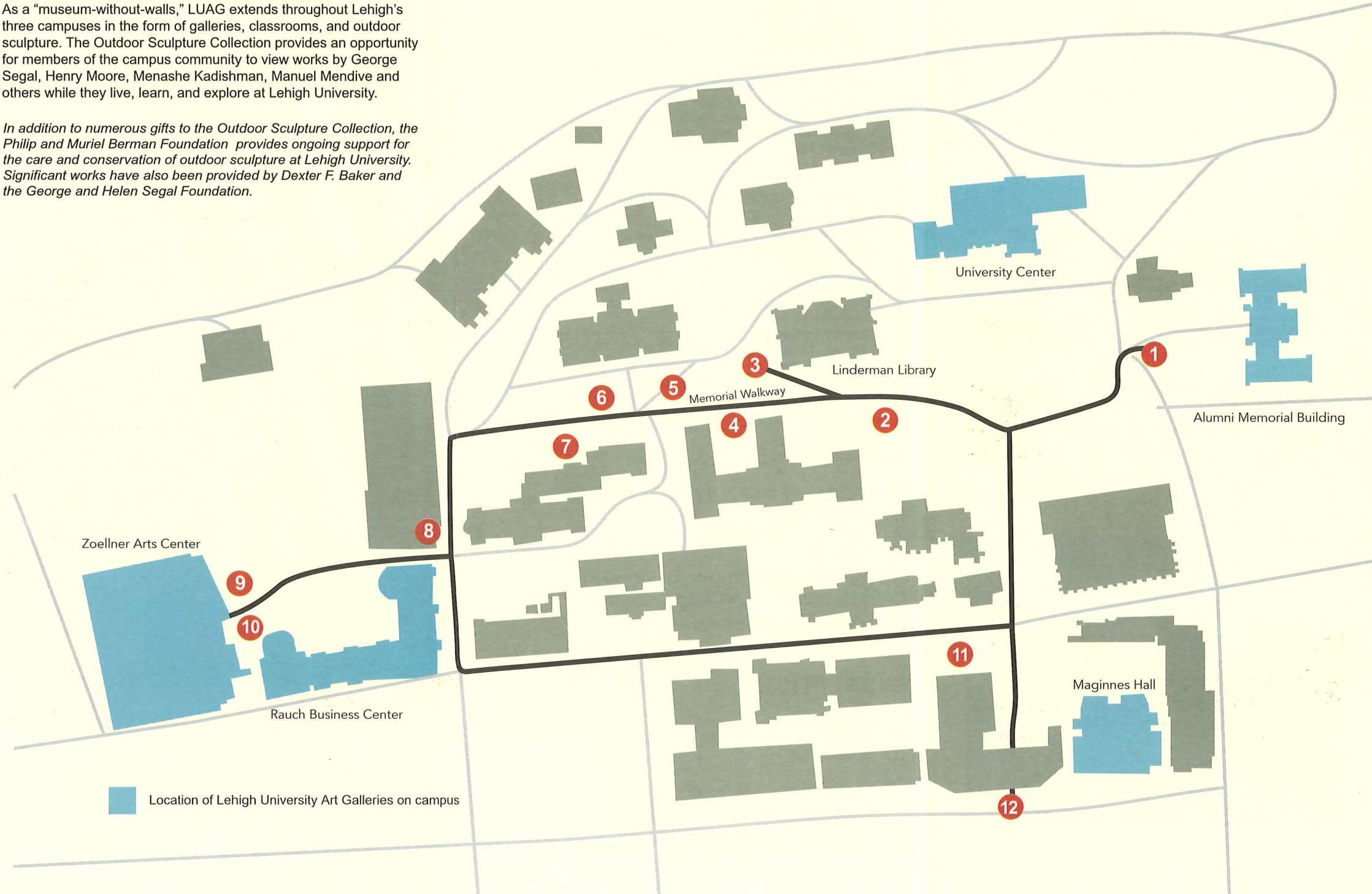
ASA PACKER CAMPUS



THE OUTDOOR SCULPTURE COLLECTION at Lehigh University is part of the LUAG Teaching Collection of over 10,000 art objects designed to inspire, develop, and promote visual literacy and cultural understanding as part of the university learning experience.

As a "museum-without-walls," LUAG extends throughout Lehigh's three campuses in the form of galleries, classrooms, and outdoor sculpture. The Outdoor Sculpture Collection provides an opportunity for members of the campus community to view works by George Segal, Henry Moore, Menashe Kadishman, Manuel Mendive and others while they live, learn, and explore at Lehigh University.
