- a current resume
- for teaching artists, images of current work or of work created by students (5 max, 300 dpi)
- for museum educators, an example of a gallery-based lesson (if available)
- a class proposal including class duration, lesson plan, student supply lists etc
 - Three professional references

BA or equivalent experience

Proficiency in another language is a plus (particularly Spanish, Mandarin, ASL or other languages)
